### GANESH CHATURTHI

## **TECH EVENTS**



#### CARDIOQUEST

The Health-O-Tech Club of VIT-Bhopal hosted CardioQuest, a three-round event, on September 29, 2023, in AB-316. This event, led by Dr. Swagat Samantaray and Dr. Ashok Kumar Patel, along with student coordinators Ms. Swati Beniwal, Mr. Jatin Madan, and Ms. Priya Shah, aimed to engage participants in healthy competition and insightful discussions.

Twenty-eight teams registered for the event. The first round, CardioQuiz, kicked off the competition on Quizlet, featuring 23 multiple-choice questions with a 30-second time limit per question. This round set the tone for the event, and all teams advanced to the second round, where their overall scores depended on the accuracy and speed of their responses.

The second round, Cardiathon, was a technical ideation. Teams had to select one problem statement from the eight provided and convert their ideas into informative presentations within an hour. The judges, Dr. Rudra Kalyan Nayak and Dr. Santosh Kumar Tripathy, gave each team six minutes to present their PPTs before probing them with questions about their theories and selected problem statements.

After careful evaluation by the panel, **Team Visioners** claimed the **first place**, **Team nitVITs** secured the **runner-up position**, and **Team Kradeet** became the **second runner-up**.

A bonus round called 'NAME YOUR HEART' was organised for the audience to participate. Team **BroCode** emerged as the **winner** and was honoured with a Hammer as a **token of appreciation**. The event received widespread praise from the audience and provided a worthy **celebration** for **World Heart Day**.

#### **NATIONAL SEMINAR**



On September 21 and 22, 2023, a two-day national seminar was held at VIT Bhopal University, sponsored by the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR), highlighting the shifting landscape of vehicular technology and transport systems. Organized by the School of Computing Science and Engineering, the seminar drew the interest of over 200 participants seeking insights into the evolving models of vehicular cloud technology and intelligent transport systems.

The inaugural day was graced by the presence of **Dr. Sandeep Singhai,** Principal Scientist at CSIR-Advanced Materials and Processes Research Institute (CSIR-AMPRI) in Bhopal, as the chief guest of the event. He delivered the inaugural address, sharing valuable insights into the innovative Vehicular Cloud Model for Vehicular Tracking and Intelligent Transport Systems. **Vice-Chancellor Dr. Senthil Kumar Arumugam** presented the presidential address, emphasizing the importance of such discussions. Our respected **Registrar, Dr. Pradyumna Yadav,** extended a felicitation, recognizing the significance of the seminar.

**Dr. S. Poonkuntran,** the Dean of the SCSE, welcomed all attendees, initiating the discussions. **Dr I. Jasmine Selvakumari Jeya**, the Organizing Secretary, outlined the seminar's objectives and topics, setting the stage for the forthcoming sessions. During the afternoon session **Dr. Ayan Mondal**, Assistant Professor-CSE at **IIT, Indore**  delivered a speech on Softwarization for Vehicular IoT.

On the second day, Dr P.B. Sujit, from the Indian Institute of Science Education and Research. led the mornina session. concentrating on the 'Guidance and Control of Unmanned Vehicles'. The discussion encompassed various topics, including multirobot systems, aerial and underwater vehicles utilized for vehicular tracking, and path following for aerial vehicles.

The afternoon session was led by Dr. Bodhisatwa Mazumdar from IIT Indore, focusing on 'Cybersecurity Aspects in Intelligent Transportation Systems.'



Dr. Mazumdar covered essential concepts such as CV (Computer Vision), V2X communication, encryption, authentication, and privacy concerns within the realm of connected vehicle communication with infrastructure.

The event concluded with the distribution of **participation certificates** to all attendees by the Dean of the School of Computing Science and Engineering, Dr. S. Poonkuntran, recognizing and appreciating the active participation and contributions of the attendees.
