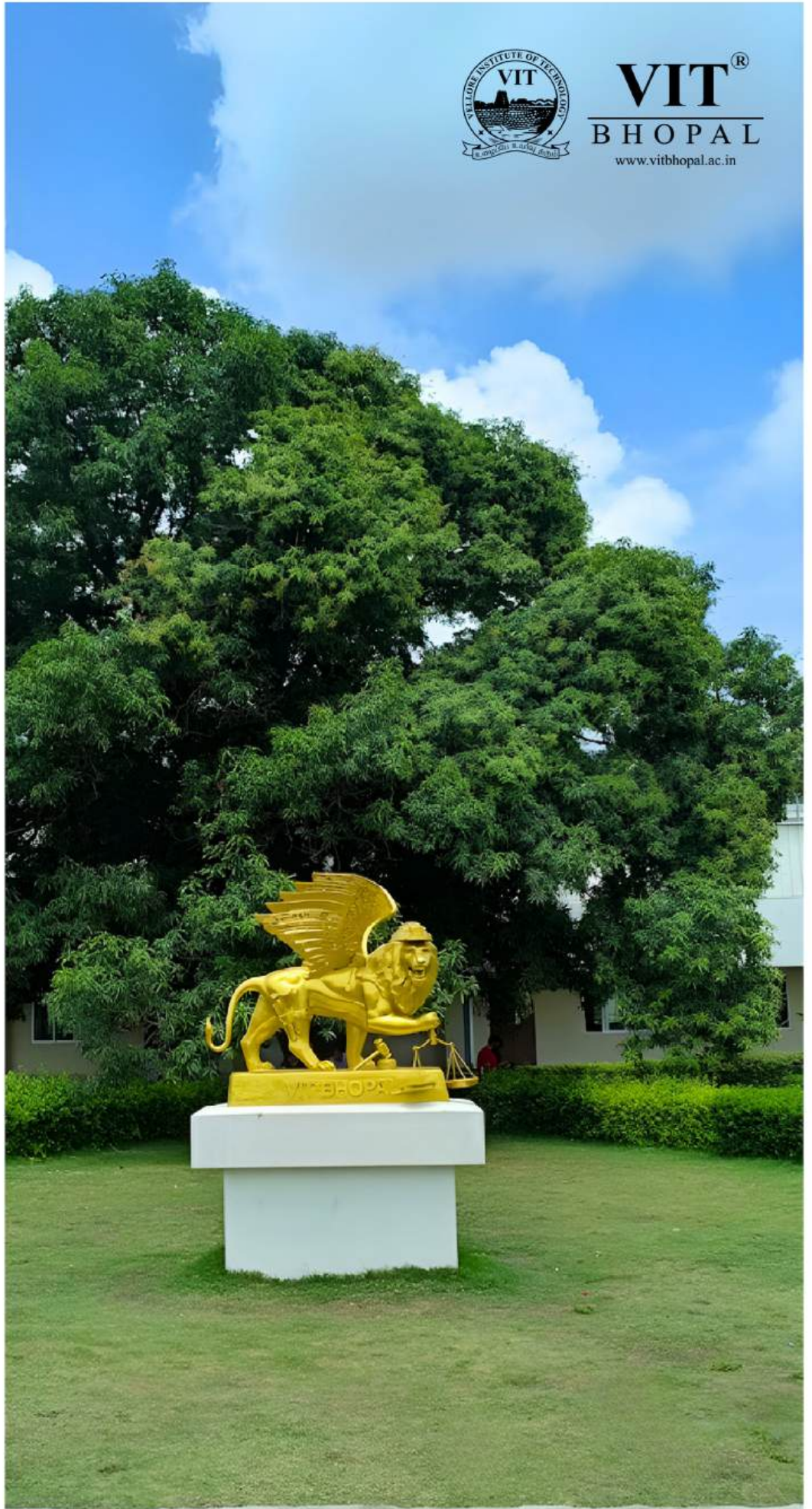

Overview

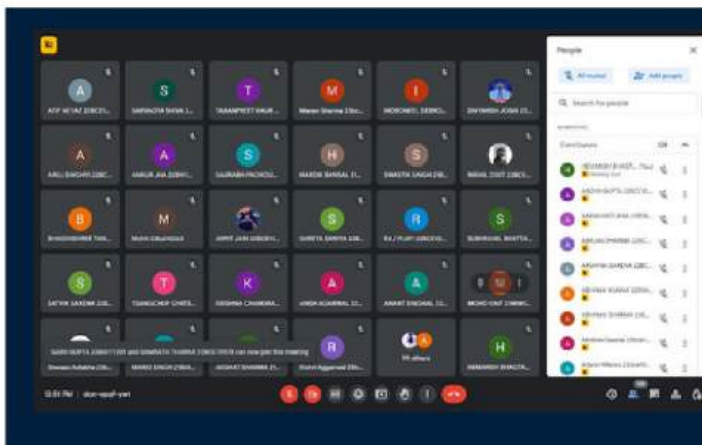

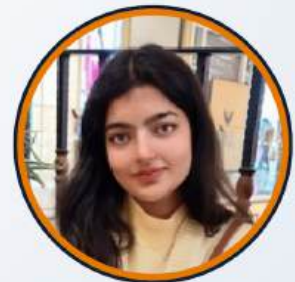
