**13 September**

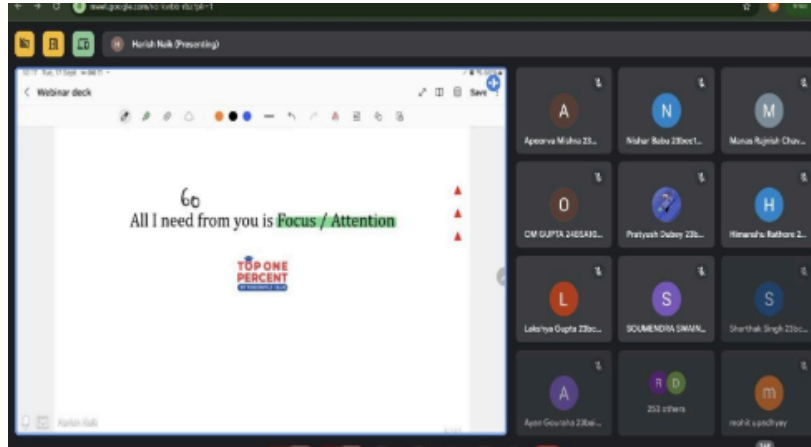

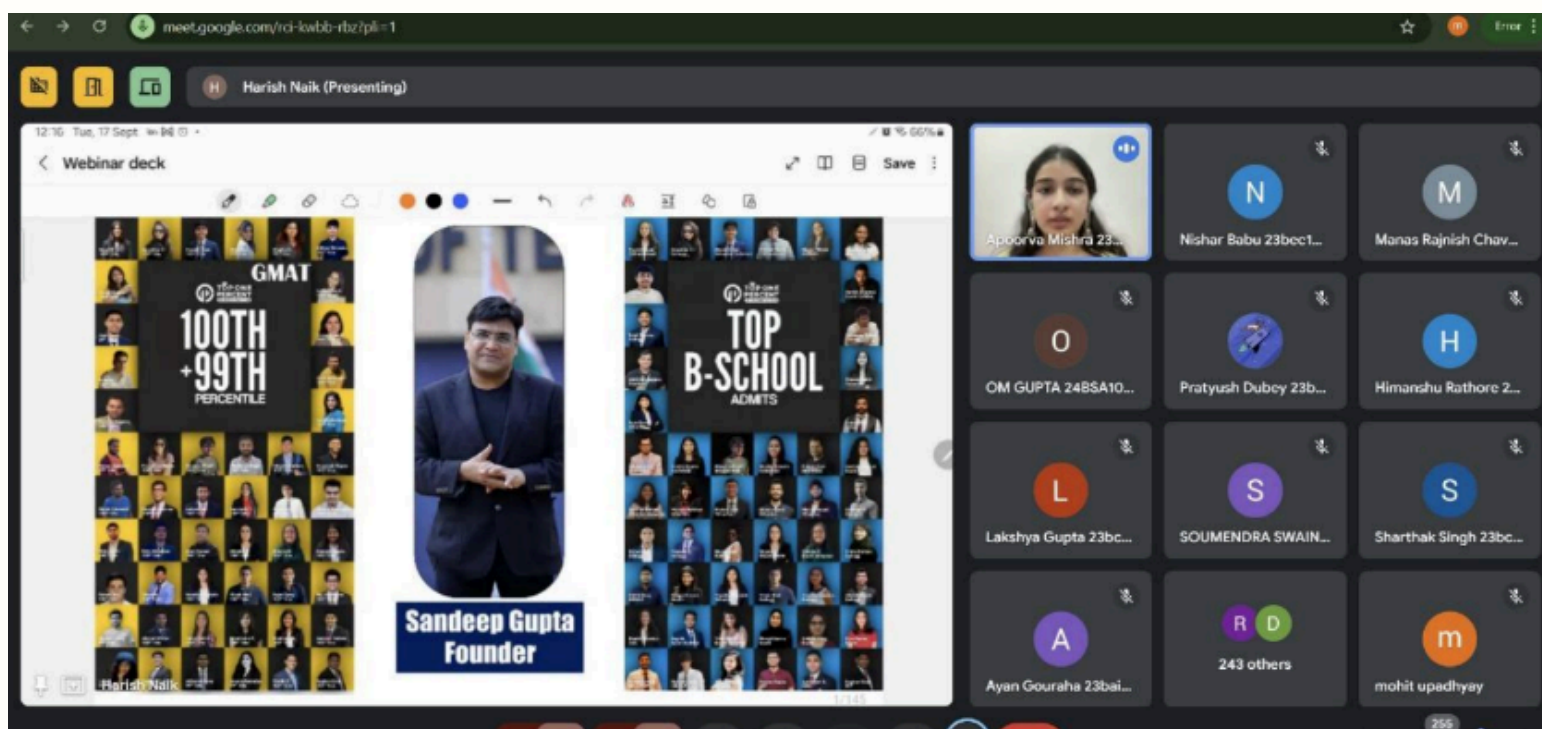
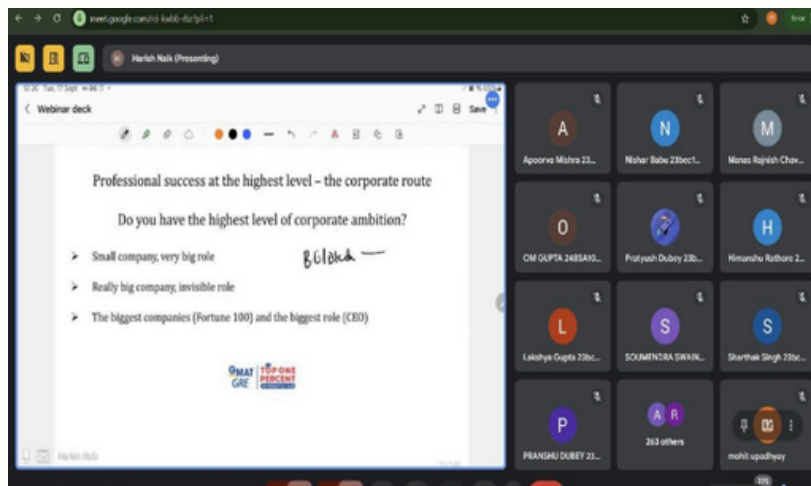


# ECELL VIT Bhopal X TOP One Percent ECELL

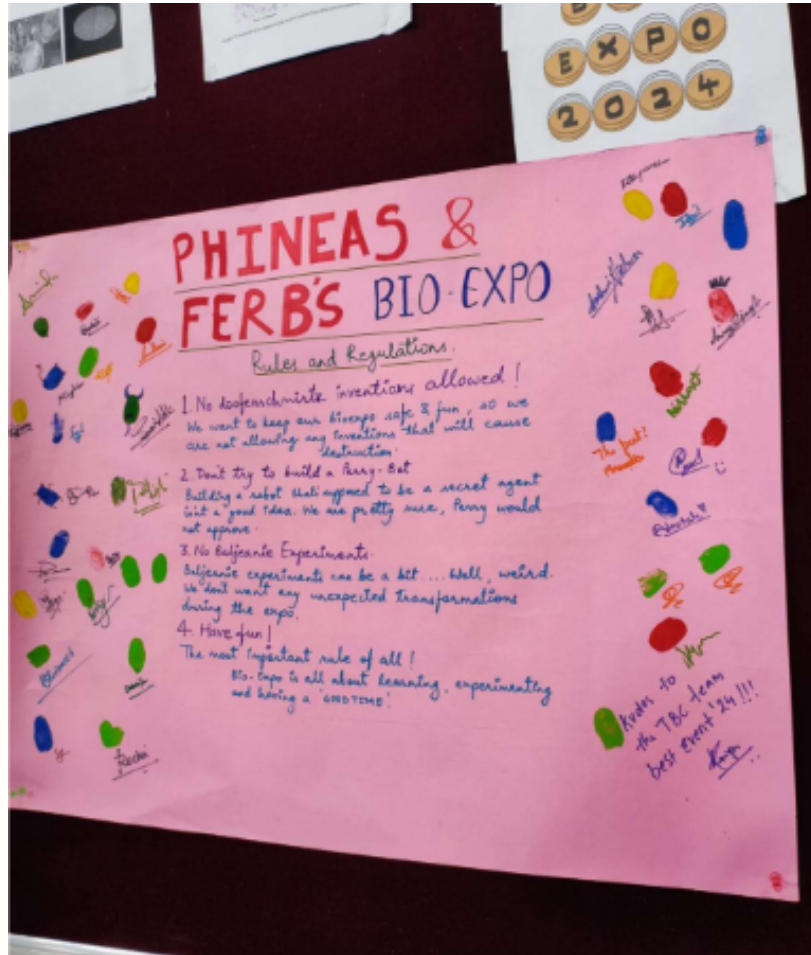

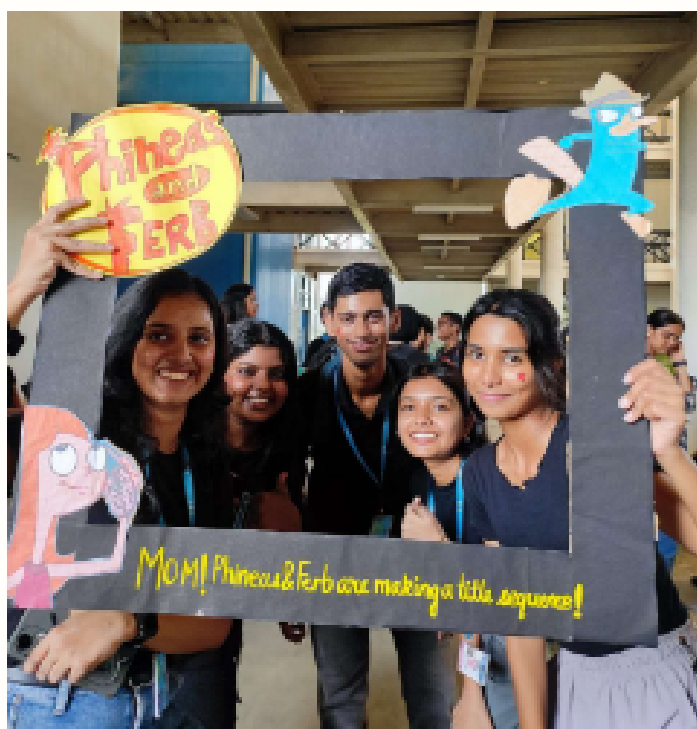
# BIOEXPO'24

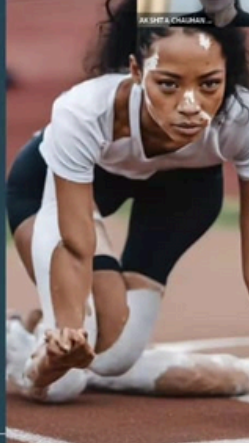
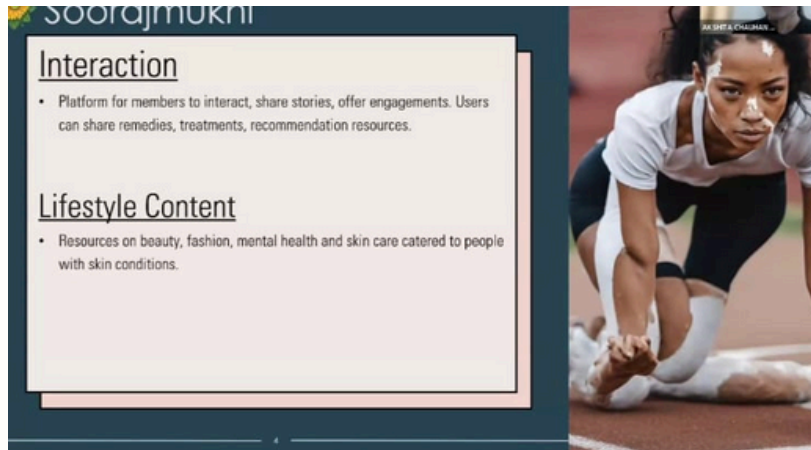

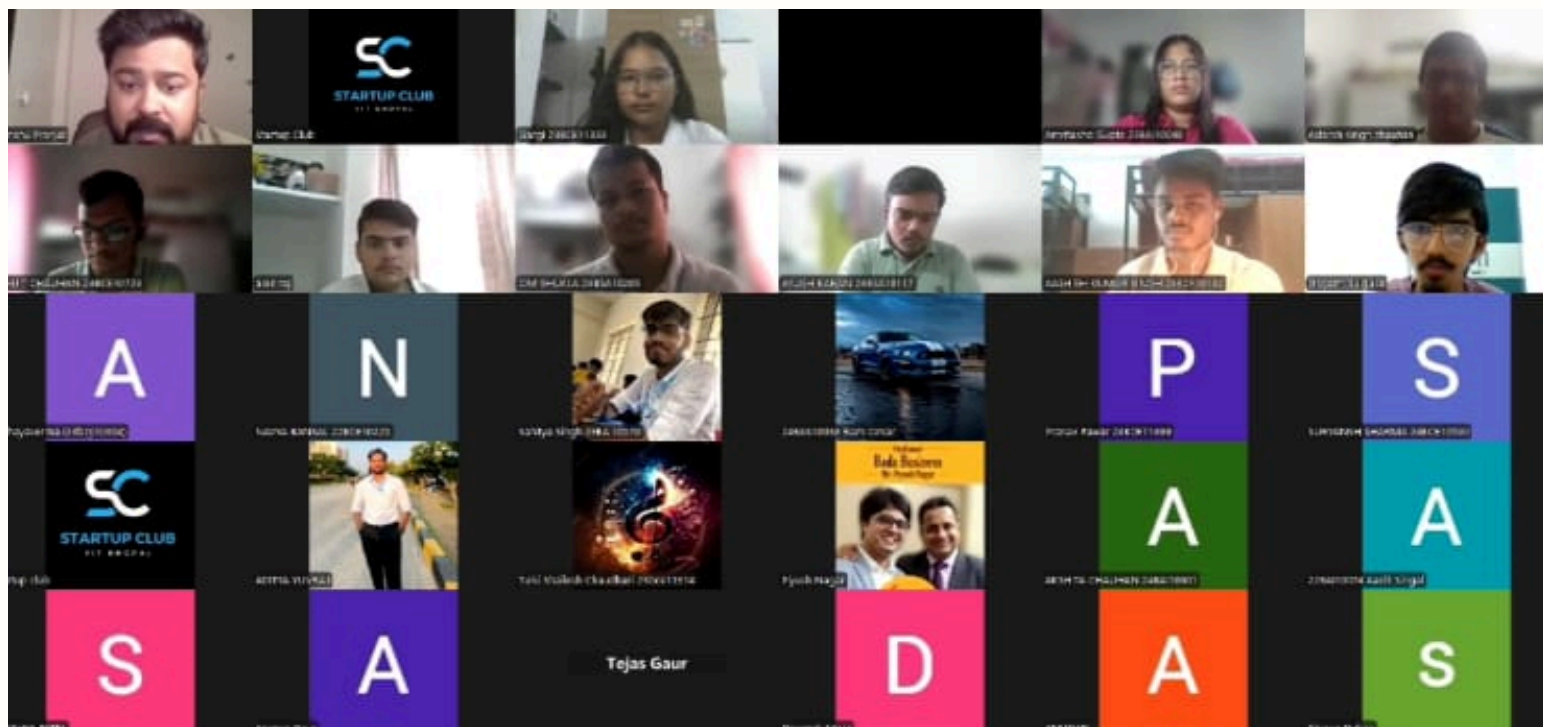
# Pitch Deck Prastuti

# VISIONARY HACKATHON

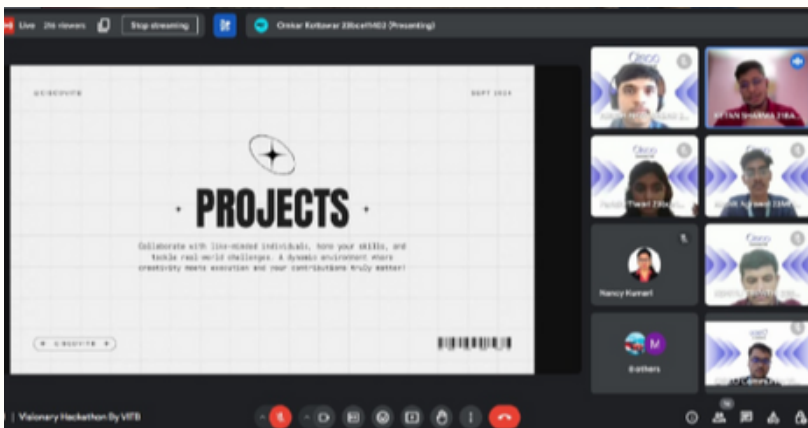
CISCO Community
