 - Significance of IPR in safeguarding academic research and innovations.

The focus of Seminar will be on equipping faculty members, research scholars and students with the necessary knowledge and skills to protect and manage their intellectual ideas effectively.

- 2. Filing Procedures and Legal Framework:
 - Step-by-step guide to filing patents, trademarks, and copyrights.

- 3. Patent Search and Prior Art Analysis:
 - How to conduct patent searches using online tools and databases.
 - Identifying prior art to ensure novelty and uniqueness of inventions.
- 4. IPR in Academic Research and Innovation:
 - Strategies for integrating IPR practices in research and development.
 - Examples of successful IPR filings from academia.

By covering these areas, the seminar aims to inspire a proactive, mission-oriented approach for managing intellectual property and fostering innovation-driven growth.
