13 September

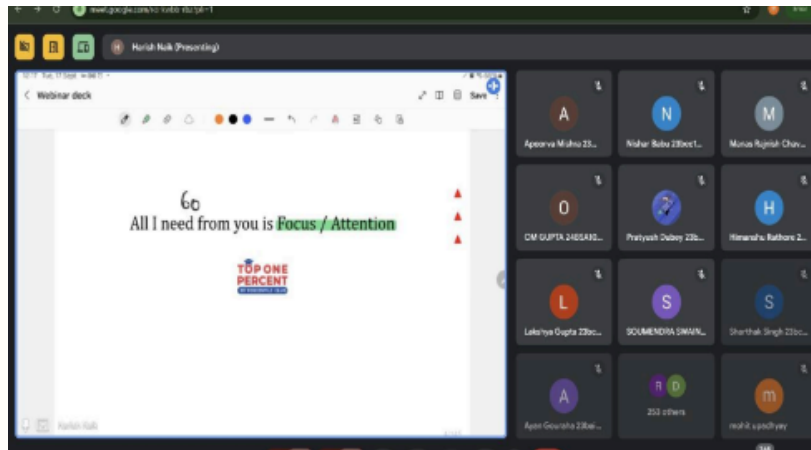

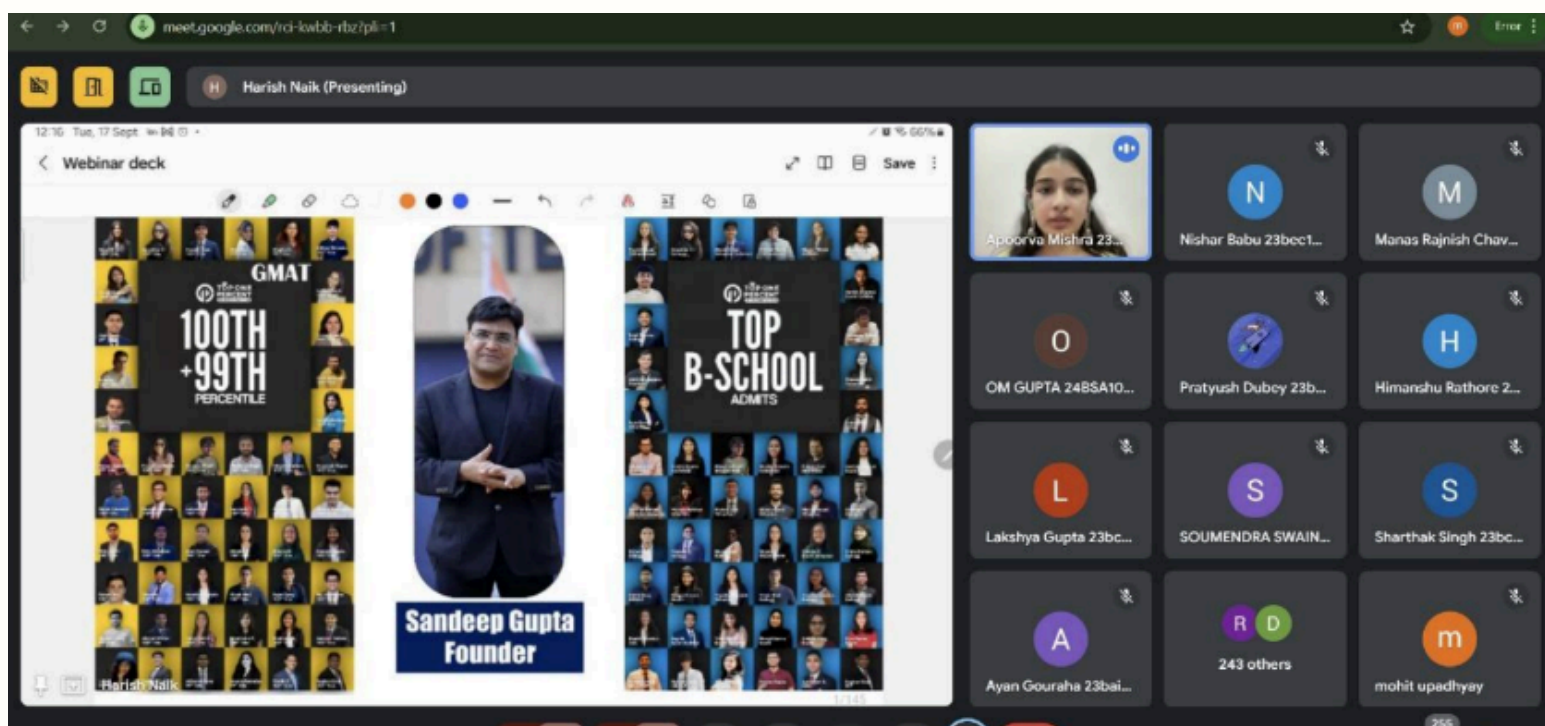
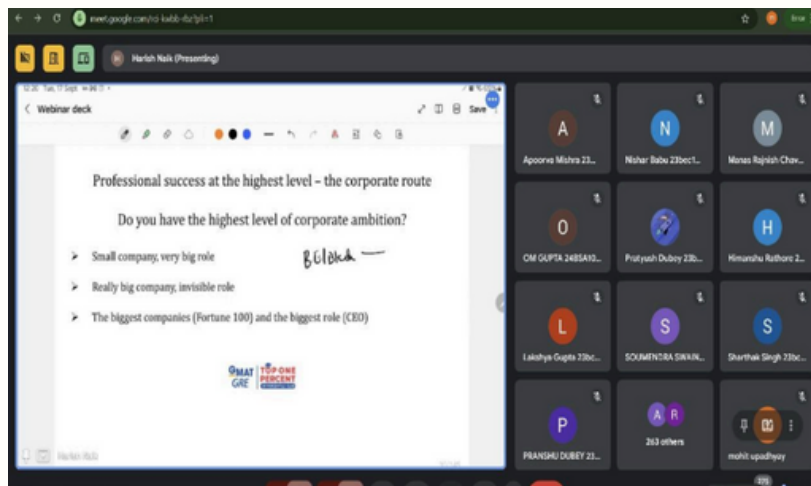


ECELL VIT Bhopal X TOP One Percent ECELL

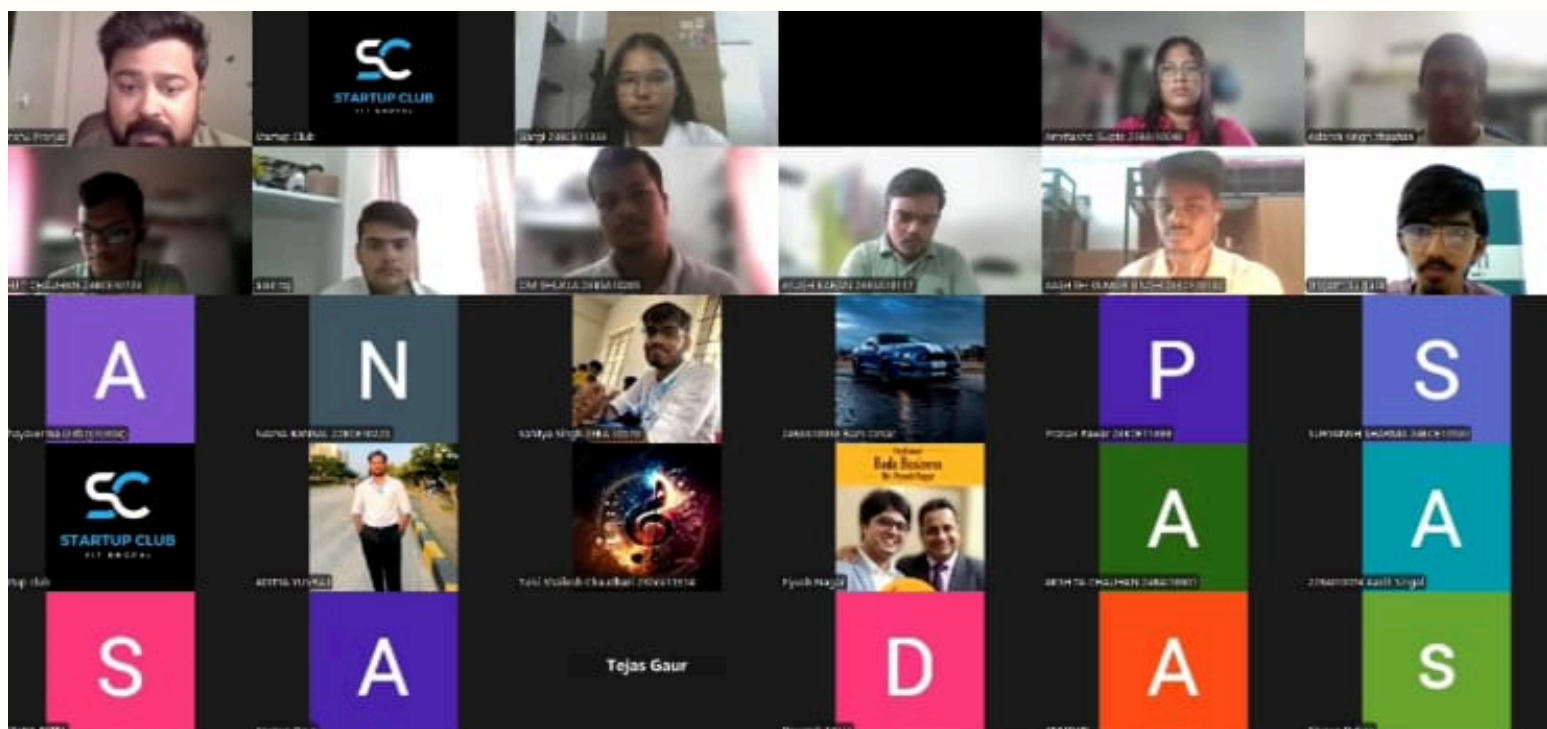
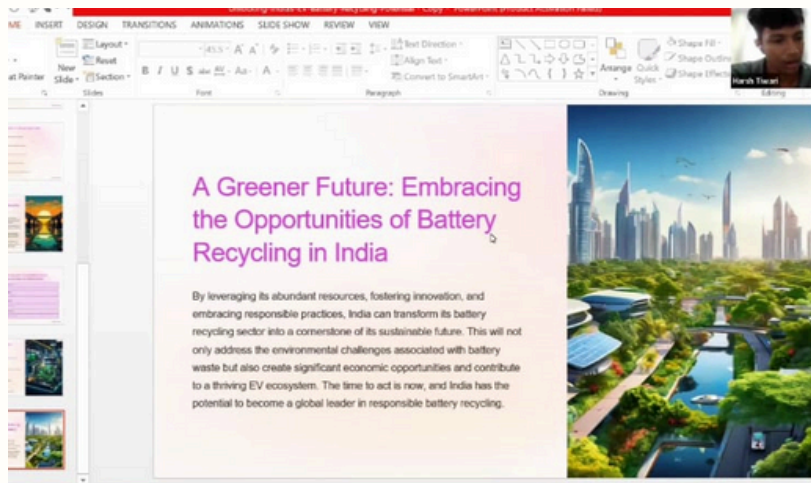
Pitch Deck Prastuti

VISIONARY HACKATHON

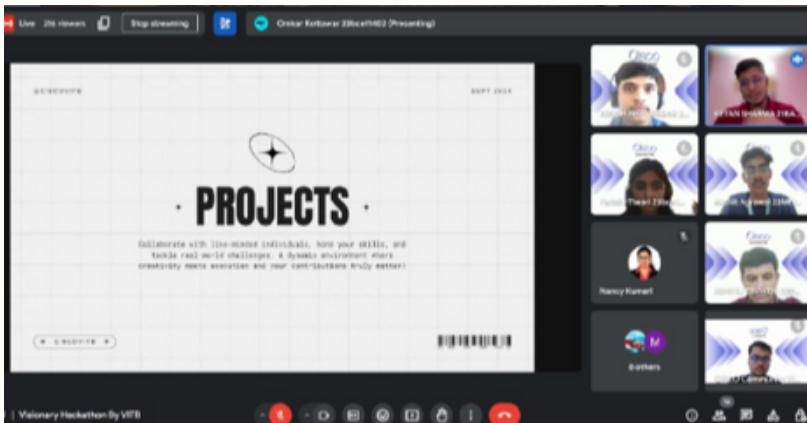
CISCO Community
